Adult Immunizations

Eligibility: Free for adults 19+ without insurance

Availability: Year round

Any adult who is nineteen or older without insurance may receive certain vaccines at no cost.

Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening

Eligibility: Free for ages 45–64 with limited income and limited or no insurance.

Availability: Year round

Help determine eligibility and obtain referrals for screenings.

Children’s Immunizations

Eligibility: Free for all

Availability: Year round

Children can receive the vaccines they need at any time with no insurance required.

This program is open to everyone, including children who:

- Don’t have health insurance
- Are on Medical Assistance or BadgerCare
- Are Native American or Alaska Native

Pregnancy Options Support

Eligibility: Free for all

Availability: Year round

Services include all options pregnancy counseling and education on pregnancy and sexual health.

Pregnancy Support

Eligibility: Pregnant individuals must meet income guidelines (eligible if enrolled in WIC, FoodShare, Medicaid, or Wisconsin Works)

Availability: Year round

Free nurse home visits during pregnancy and up to two years after birth.

Tuberculosis Testing

Eligibility: Individuals with risk factors (ex. Born in or have lived in a country where TB disease is more common). Do not test for work, school, or volunteering.

Availability: Year round

People of all ages with risk factors can call (608) 266-4821 to see if they qualify for testing.

Sexual and Reproductive Health

Eligibility: Free or low cost

Availability: Year round

Services include:

- Birth control and emergency contraception
- STD/STI testing and treatment
- Sexual health supplies

Syringe Services

Eligibility: Free for all

Availability: Year round

Services include:

- Safer injection drug use equipment
- Sharps disposal boxes and used sharps disposal
- Fentanyl and Xylazine drug testing strips
- Nasal and injectable naloxone
- Condoms and lube
- Risk reduction information

Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Nutrition Program

Eligibility: For people who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or postpartum, as well as infants and children up to age five, who live in Wisconsin.

Availability: Year round

Services include:

- Healthy food benefits
- Personalized nutrition education
- Breastfeeding support
- Referrals to other services

Animal Services

Eligibility: Free for all

Availability: Year round

Services include:

- Help with animal bites, stray animals, and animal welfare concerns
- Help with wildlife that poses an immediate threat to health or safety
