



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Droster Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1979. Some improvements have been made to Droster Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 1995.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, basketball court, backstop, drinking fountain, engineering path, and a park path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed park amenities include an additional park path and managed meadow.

Special Conditions

Stormwater Engineering greenway in southern portion of park. 10' sanitary easment north of Buckeye Road on south end of park.
