



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Elvehjem Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1965. Some improvements have been made to Elvehjem Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 1995.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a nature nook, shelter, community gardens, all-wheel spot, and a park driveway/path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed changes include updating the park shelter, adding a community patio with games and garden area around the shelter, removing and replacing the nature nook, adding new paved paths connecting to the all-wheel spot, adding new benches, and additional park signage.

Special Conditions

Community Garden lease. Adding a new walking path through Elvehjem Elementary School property would require entering a joint-use agreement with the Madison Metropolitan School District.
