



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Heritage Heights Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1963. Some improvements have been made to Heritage Heights Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 1995.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, tennis/pickleball courts, a shelter, basketball court, backstop, path path, and engineering path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed park facilities include a new basketball court, an updated playground, path replacement, tree planting, a volleyball net, and managed meadow.

Special Conditions

Stormwater greenway along north edge of park maintained by City Engineering. Little Free Library to east of park along Valley Rd.
