



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Lake Edge Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1961. Some improvements have been made to Lake Edge Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 1995.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, basketball court, backstop, and park path.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed amenities include a new park path, new oak trees, a gathering space with log seating, and managed meadow.

Special Conditions

Water easement and monitoring well agreement in Northwest corner of park. Electric easement in Southeast corner of park. Neighborhood agreement for gathering circle North of shelter.
