



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Monona Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1939. Some improvements have been made to Monona Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 2011.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground and a park path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed park facilities include a new sun shelter and accessible park path.

Special Conditions

Multi-use field space is maintained and leased by Madison Metropolitan School District and is not reservable through Madison Parks. Building a new walking path through Ray F. Sennet Middle School/Robert M. La Follette High School property would require entering a joint-use agreement with the MMSD.
